I am requesting funding for the City of Phoenix's Fire Wildland Urban Interface project in Fiscal Year 2026. The funding would be used for the acquisition of a Type 3 wildland firefighting engine and two supplemental ambulances to enhance emergency response capabilities in South Phoenix.
