I am requesting funding for the Valley Metro Community Safety Project in Fiscal Year 2026. The funding would be used to fund staffing, training, and equipment for teams who will work with community members who may be in crisis or are near crisis. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it establishes and enhances a community partnership of law enforcement, the Valley Metro security team, and mental health and addiction professionals to interface with the homeless population on the transit system. This added staff capacity will alleviate burdens on local law enforcement, freeing up police capacity to respond to violent crime and lower response times.
